# Ordinance Allowing Sales of Alcohol in Closed Containers by "Class B" License Holders Amended February 2021

# **Ordinance # O-01-2011**

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Sherman Dunn County

#### SECTION I- TITLE AND PURPOSE

This ordinance is entitled to the Town of Sherman allowing sale of alcohol in the Town of Sherman

#### SECTION II -AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Sherman, Dunn County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 125.51 (3) (b), Wis. Statues., to adopt this ordinance.

## SECTION III- ADOPTION

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides that any holder of a "Class B" intoxicating liquor license may sell intoxicating liquor in the original package or container, in any quantity, for consumption off the premises where sold. Wine may be sold for off-premise consumption in any quantity.

### SECTION IV-SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

#### SECTION V-EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. <u>60.80</u>, Wis. stats.
